# CHILDREN, TEACHERS, FAMILIES, AND SOCIAL SERVICE AGENCIES SERVED DURING OREGON CHILDREN'S THEATRE'S 2010-2011 SEASON

## PRODUCTIONS

24,927 family members attended a performance of *Alice and Wonderland*; *Diary of a Worm, a Spider, and a Fly*; *On the Eve of Friday Morning*; *How I Became a Pirate*, *A Wrinkle in Time*; or the Young Professionals productions of *Antigone Now*; *Impulse! Improv*; or *Chamber Music*.

## OUTREACH

1,164 children from social service agency partners received free tickets to an OCT production, and 61 participated in free classes at the venues of our partners. Social service agency partners include Big Brothers/Big Sisters, Boys & Girls Clubs, Friends of the Children, Shriners Hospital, St. Mary's Home for Boys, PHAME Academy, DHS Child Welfare, Community Partners for Affordable Housing, Starlight Foundation, and Children's Cancer Association.

## SCHOOL SERVICES

58,471 students from 458 schools attended a field trip performance during the 2010-2011 school year. OCT provides funding assistance to schools where at least 70% of students qualify for free or reduced lunch; 9,159 students from economically disadvantaged schools received full or partial scholarships to attend.

## SERVICES FOR TEACHERS

200 teachers attended free performances to preview the play before attending with their classes, and 47 teachers participated in free professional development workshops. 177 teachers participated in the Teacher Liaison program, which provides teachers behind-the-scenes information on OCT and gives them the opportunity to advise OCT on program development and our educational services.

## ACTING ACADEMY

1,166 young people took an OCT Acting Academy class this year. 103 students received full or partial scholarships. 54 students participated in the Young Professionals program, a mentorship program for dedicated students seeking advanced theater training.



## EDUCATIONAL THEATRE PROGRAM

23,214 students from 120 schools attended free Educational Theatre Program performances. Oregon Children's Theatre partners with Kaiser Permanente to present free productions at schools, which engage young people about decisions that shape the quality of their health and their lives.

## LOUD AND CLEAR

2,184 students from 91 classrooms participated in Loud and Clear, in-school workshops to help students achieve benchmark standards in public speaking.

# NEWS & NOTES

## NATIONAL FUNDING

OCT received significant funding from several national sources, including a generous grant from the National Endowment for the Arts, as well as grants from The Hearst Foundations (California), The Shubert Foundation (New York), and Children's Theatre Foundation of America.

## AWARDS

OCT was honored with Portland Area Musical Theater Awards for Outstanding Production, Outstanding Direction, and Outstanding Musical Direction for *Alice and Wonderland*. In addition, the Portland Drama Critics Board awarded Jack Clevenger an Outstanding Young Performer Drammy for his performance in *A Wrinkle in Time*, and two of OCT's Young Professionals, Sydney Dufka and Tyler Parker, received scholarships from the Portland Civic Theatre Guild.

## IMAGINATION LUNCHEON

400 business and community leaders attended OCT's 2011 Imagination Luncheon to honor Friends of the Children Founder Duncan Campbell. The event raised \$23,701 in donations and a total income of \$54,251. All proceeds from the luncheon support OCT's services for teachers, families, and schools in the community.

## NEW PLAY DEVELOPMENT

OCT commissioned the world premiere production of *Diary of a Worm, a Spider, and a Fly*. Six theaters across the country, including Dallas Children's Theater and First Stage Children's Theater (Wisconsin), have already added the production to their 2011-2012 seasons.
